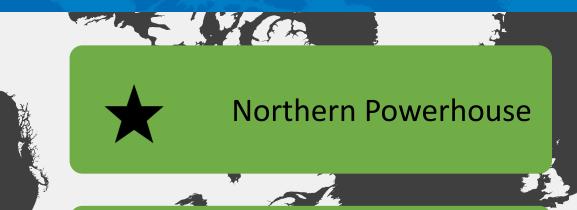

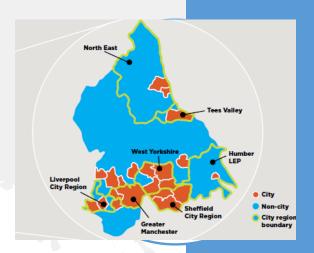

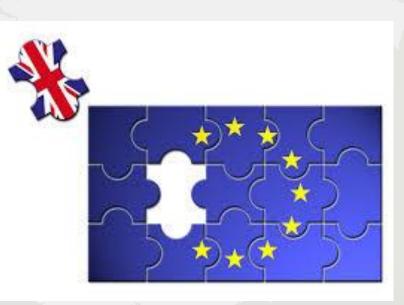
The Brexit Opportunity

 Ireland is seen as a thought leader on Brexit





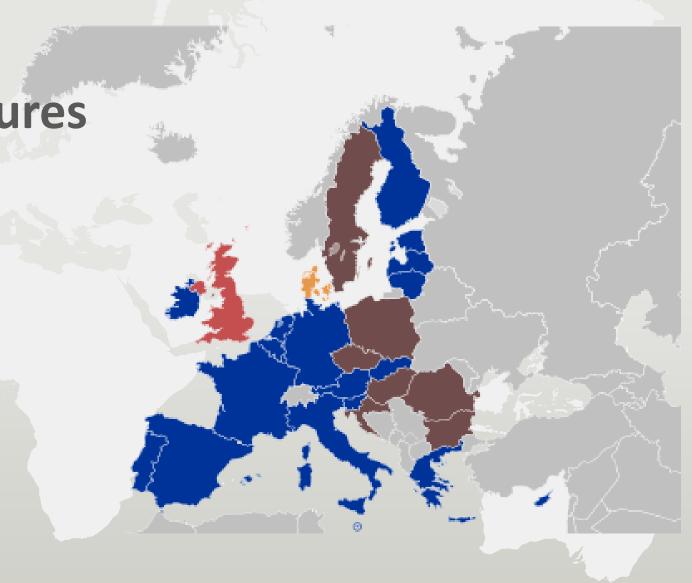
Eurozone offers particular advantages

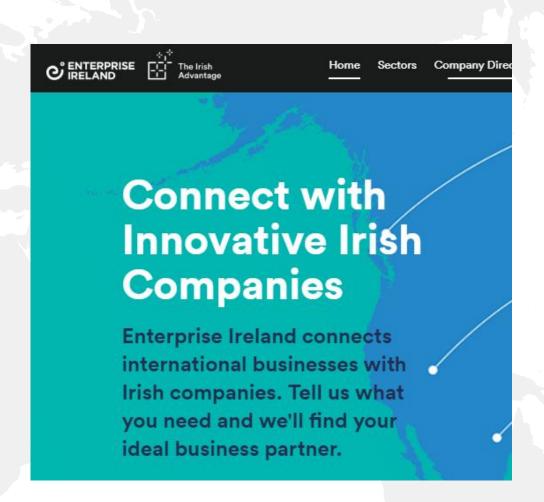

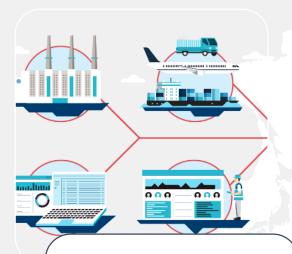
